### Volunteer Liability Waiver

I understand that the job(s) I have checked on page one of the Volunteer Application Form, as well as any tasks related to volunteering, may be dangerous and carry with them certain inherent risks, including risks that may not be obvious, and that cannot reasonably be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries.
